- ExchangeHut was started in 2004 as a local student textbook exchange to help students at the University of Wisconsin save money on textbooks.
- Our goal is to make ExchangeHut the number one national website that will allow college students to save money on their textbooks, making college more affordable for all.

How We Address the Textbook Problem

- ExchangeHut eliminates the middleman, which allows students to buy and sell directly among each other.
- On average, our users save \$150.00 per semester buying their textbooks through ExchangeHut.
- We also allow students to view and purchase books of local bookstores (not affiliated with the University) which have cheaper prices and pay more for buyback.
- When a student searches for a book, ExchangeHut will give them the price of the book on other affiliate websites, like amazon.com.

Summary:

- Our site provides students with three methods to buy and sell textbooks, all of which save them money. We enable them to purchase books at a much cheaper price and let them compare prices of the three cheapest places to buy a book. If all students fully use ExchangeHut, it will highly reduce the money students spend on textbooks each semester.
