## **Resolution Agreement**

Bossier Parish Community College OCR Complaint #06142280

The Bossier Parish Community College (BPCC) voluntarily submits this Resolution Agreement (Agreement) to the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), Dallas Office. By this Agreement, the BPCC commits to the following actions, consistent with the requirements of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), 29 U.S.C. § 794, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Title II), 42 U.S.C. §§ 12131 et seq., and their respective implementing regulations, to resolve the allegations raised in the above-referenced complaint.

The BPCC understands that by signing this Agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner. Further, the BPCC understands that during the monitoring of this Agreement, OCR may visit the BPCC, interview staff and students, and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether the BPCC has fulfilled the terms of the Agreement and is in compliance with the statute and regulations that were at issue in this case.

The BPCC understands that OCR will not close the monitoring of this Agreement until such time that OCR determines that the BPCC has fulfilled the terms of the Agreement and is in compliance with the statute and regulation that were at issue in this case.

The BPCC understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate administrative enforcement or judicial proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of the Agreement. Before initiating administrative enforcement (34 C.F.R. §§ 100.9, 100.10), or judicial proceedings to enforce the Agreement, OCR shall give the BPCC written notice of the alleged breach and 60 calendar days to cure the alleged breach.

Unless otherwise noted, all structural changes or modifications to existing facilities pursuant to this Agreement will be in accordance with the technical and scoping requirements of the DOJ's 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design, 28 C.F.R. Part 36, Appendix A (2010 Standards). Compliance with the 2010 Standards is required for new construction and alterations initiated on or after March 15, 2012.
