This is to inform you that the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR) is discontinuing its investigation of the referenced complaint of discrimination against Longview School District No. 122. Specifically, the complaint alleged that the district discriminated against a parent based on disability by issuing a no-trespass order against him at XXXXXXXXX, which was effective XXXXX.

OCR accepted this complaint for resolution under the authority of section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1972 and title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and their implementing regulations. The district has agreed to take the actions set forth in the enclosed Voluntary Resolution Agreement, which, when fully implemented, will resolve the issues raised by the complaint. OCR will monitor the implementation of the agreement and will close the complaint when OCR determines that the terms of the agreement have been satisfied.
