Dear Superintendent Boland:

This is to inform you that the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR) is discontinuing its investigation of the above-referenced discrimination complaint against Idaho Falls School District 91. The complaint alleged that the district discriminates against individuals with disabilities because the restrooms at the administration are not accessible, and there is no accessible route to the lower level of the administration building.

OCR accepted this complaint for resolution under the authority of section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and their implementing regulations.

The district has agreed to take the actions set forth in the enclosed voluntary resolution agreement, which, when fully implemented, will resolve the issues raised by the complaint.

OCR will monitor the implementation of the agreement and will close the complaint when OCR determines that the terms of the agreement have been satisfied. The first report under the agreement is due by May 30, 2014.
