Voluntary Retirement:

Type 1: 5 years service @ age 62 **Supervisor:** All full-time employees who have the authority to hire, direct, assign, promote, etc.
 20 years service @ age 60 **Other:** All full-time employees who are not a supervisor
 30 years service @ age 55
 Type 4: 10 years service @ age 55 This report includes full-time permanent employees excluding political appointees and Schedule C's.

Discontinued Service Retirement (DSR):

Type 2: 25 years service @ any age
 Type 3: 20 years of service @ age 50
