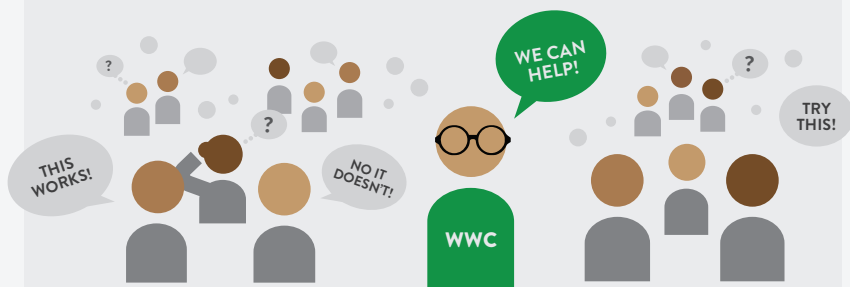


WHAT IS THE WWC?

Hundreds of trained and certified **reviewers** rate whether studies meet **standards** and then **summarize** results that do meet standards.

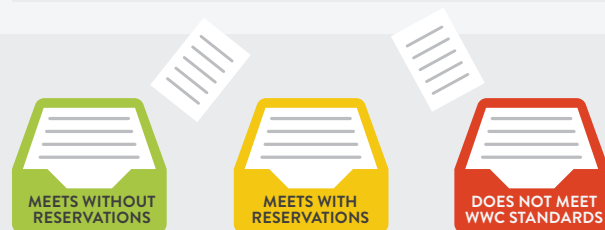
