

ABSTRACT for College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP@ASU)

Adams State University's CAMP (CAMP@ASU) objectives support **three goals** to meet migrant student postsecondary needs: **1)** outreach/recruitment, **2)** academic and student support services, and **3)** financial support and education. **Expected Outcomes of Project-** Annual targets: ***Outreach*** to 300 potentially eligible migrant students per year; ***Participants recruited/enrolled:*** 30 eligible full-time, first-year MSFW students per year (est. 29 residential, 1 commuter per year; 150 students over 5 years); ***Academic & Student Support:*** 100% (30 participants) have an Academic Success Plan and a mentor; ***Performance Measure 1:*** 26 of 30 students (86%) complete 1st year; ***Performance Measure 2:*** 24 of 26 students (92%) continue into 2nd year; ***Financial Aid & Education:*** 100% (30) receive financial support; 100% of 1st-year students and continuing alumni receive financial aid advising and financial literacy training.

CAMP@ASU Activities: Regional site visits to intensify outreach to migrant students, need-based participant selection, summer counseling (based on *Promising Evidence* study), advising, CAMP residential learning community and career readiness workshops, peer mentoring, tutoring, financial aid and advising, and progress monitoring throughout student years at ASU.

Supporting strategies: effective partnerships and linkages to resources to maximize student benefit, parent/family outreach, data-based academic support practices, and continuous program improvement through participant/stakeholder surveys, data-monitoring, and evaluation. **One site:** ASU campus. **Meets Invitational Priority:** A holistic program of wrap-around support services, partnerships, and ASU staff trainings in migrant culture foster inclusivity and sense of belonging, academic achievement, and self-efficacy to meet students' social, emotional, and academic needs and promote persistence and completion. **CPP:** CAMP@ASU is eligible for experience points.
