California State University, Fresno proposes a College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP) **on its campus**, to serve **45 first-time freshmen, commuter students from migrant and seasonal farmwork backgrounds** from the central San Joaquin Valley in California.

CAMP's overarching goal is to provide students with the academic foundation they need to successfully reach their educational and career goals through the following **goals and objectives**: Goal 1: Increase awareness of, and access to, postsecondary educational opportunities amongst migrant and seasonal farmworker (MSFW) students and their families, Objective 1.0: 45 eligible MSFW students served each project year. Goal 2: CAMP students will receive wraparound support services to maximize their college experience and achieve academic success, Objective 2.1: 86% of first year students will successfully complete 24 credit hours = Performance Measure 1 (PM 1), Objective 2.2: 92% of CAMP students who complete their first academic year of college will continue in postsecondary education = Performance Measure 2 (PM 2). Goal 3: Monitor progress of CAMP alumni and provide follow-up services, Objective 3.0: Follow-up services will be provided to eligible CAMP alumni. The measurable outcomes of the project are: Number of eligible migrant students enrolled each program year, Number of students completing 24 credit hours who have a GPA demonstrating Satisfactory Academic Progress, Number of CAMP first-year completers who return to enroll in postsecondary education after their first year, Number of CAMP alumni enrolled in postsecondary education, and Number of CAMP alumni who complete a college degree. Fresno State CAMP's goals and objectives are designed to meet students' social, emotional, and academic needs (*Invitational Preference Priority*). Fresno State CAMP is proposing to continue CAMP services that have been in existence for 35 years at Fresno State University (*Competitive Preference Priority*).
