

## Proposal to Require the Addition of Enrollment Intensity Data on the Program Information Website

### Summary and Purpose

This proposed change would specify that the program information website established under §668.43(d)(1) and maintained by the Secretary must additionally include the percentages of students in a program who were enrolled full-time and less-than-full-time during the most recent award year. Including these percentages will provide useful context for interpreting other variables required on the program information website—notably, the proposed addition by the Department of median length of calendar time taken for full-time and less-than-full-time students to complete the program’s academic requirements, and (if included) completion and withdrawal rates for full-time and less-than-full-time students. Both the total number of individuals enrolled in the program and the enrollment intensity of those individuals are data elements readily available to the Department, introducing negligible burden to construct and include these percentage values.

Proposed Language (proposed addition highlighted in red):

### PART 668—STUDENT ASSISTANCE GENERAL PROVISIONS

#### Subpart D—Institutional and Financial Assistance Information for Students

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§ 668.43 Institutional and programmatic information.

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(d)(1) *Program information website.* ~~Beginning on July 1, 2026, t~~The Secretary will establish and maintain a website with information about institutions and their educational programs. For this purpose, an institution must provide to the Department such information about the institution and its programs as the Secretary prescribes through a notice published in the *Federal Register*. The Secretary may conduct consumer testing to inform the design of the website.

(i) The website must include, but is not limited to, the following items, to the extent reasonably available:

(A) The published length of the program in calendar time (i.e., weeks, months, years).

(B) As calculated by the Secretary, the median length of calendar time (i.e., weeks, months, years) taken for full-time and less-than-full-time students to complete the program's academic requirements and obtain the degree or credential awarded by the program.

(~~CB~~) The total number of individuals enrolled in the program during the most recently completed award year.

(D) Of the individuals enrolled in the program during the most recently completed award year, the percentages who were enrolled full-time and less-than-full-time.

(~~EDE~~) The total cost of tuition and fees, and the total cost of books, supplies, and equipment, that a student would incur for completing the program within the published length of the program.

(~~EED~~) Of the individuals enrolled in the program during the most recently completed award year, the percentage who received a Direct Loan Program loan, a private loan, or both for enrollment in the program.

(~~GFE~~) As calculated by the Secretary, the median loan debt of students who completed the program during the most recently completed award year or for all students who completed or withdrew from the program during that award year.

(~~HGF~~) As provided by the Secretary, the median earnings of students who completed the program as obtained under 34 CFR 668.404(c), or of all students who completed or withdrew from the program, during a period determined by the Secretary.

(~~IHG~~) Whether the program is programmatically accredited and the name of the accrediting agency, as reported to the Secretary.

(~~IH~~) As calculated by the Secretary, the program's debt-to-earnings rates.

(~~JF~~) As calculated by the Secretary, the program's earnings premium measure.
