Recognized postsecondary credential: A credential consisting of an industry-recognized certificate or certification, a certificate of completion of an apprenticeship, a ~~license recognized by the State involved or Federal Government~~ college or university-issued credential affirming completion of a course of study that may lead to a State- or Federally-recognized license, or an associate or baccalaureate degree, that meets the requirements under 34 CFR 668.8.

Rationale: This language clarifies the role of a credential program that leads to licensure and delineates this explicitly for students, institutions, and stakeholders.
