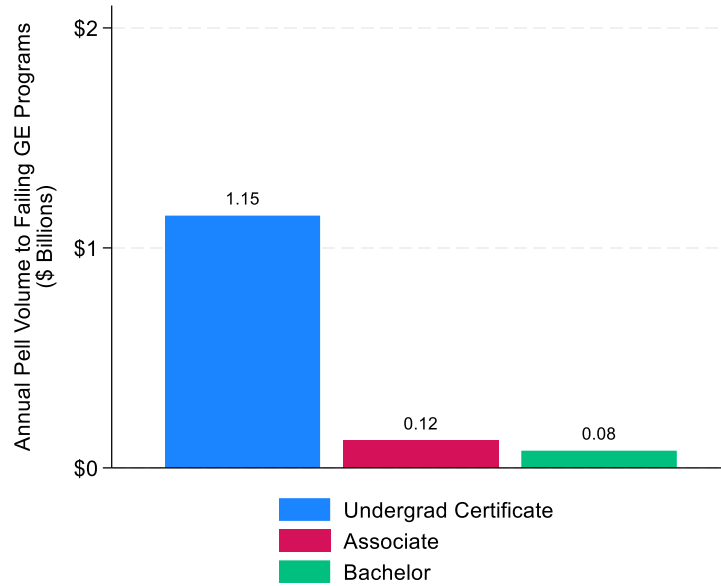
Analysis on Pell Grant and Federal Student Loan Disbursements To programs estimated to fail the Department's proposed GE Rule

The following analysis is provided by the Department in response to a request by negotiators representing Public Institutions of Higher Education.

The analysis shows the annual amount of Federal student aid recipients and Federal student aid disbursements to GE programs that are estimated to pass and fail the GE-test in the Department's proposed rule. The analysis uses disbursements from the 2025 award year.

Dollar values are measured in 2025 nominal dollars, and estimates are derived using the 2026 Program Performance Data (PPD:26).

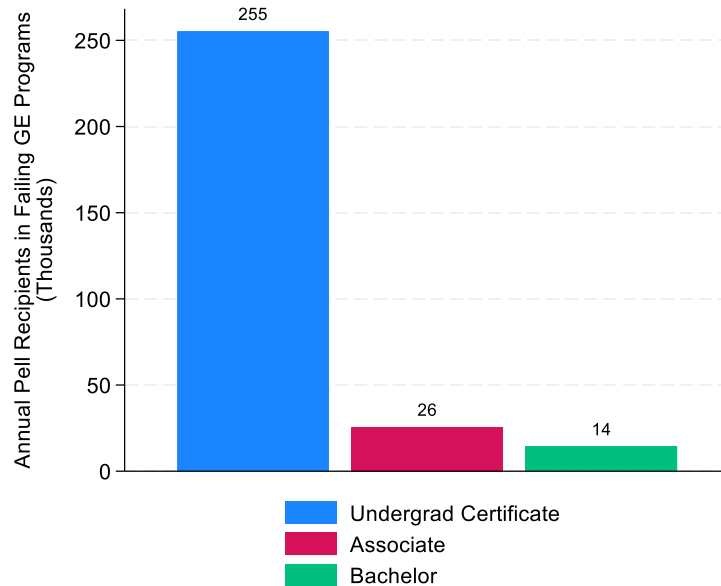
Figure 1. Annual Pell Grant Volume to Failing GE Programs (AY2025)

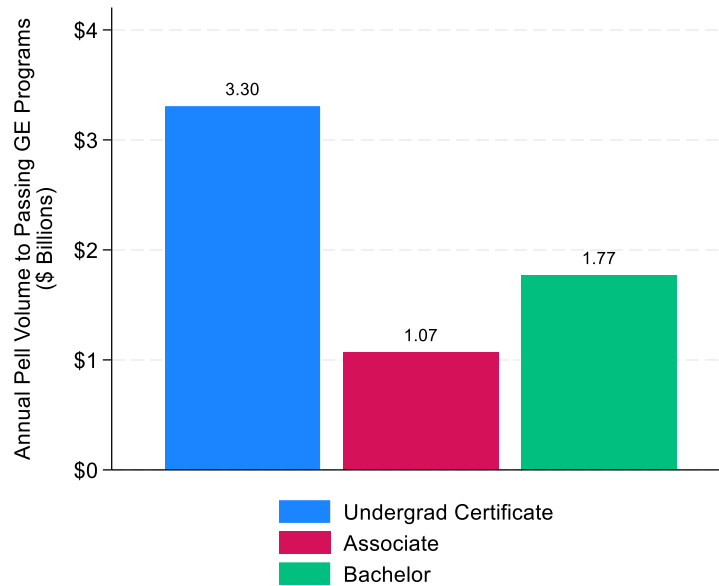
Figure 2. Annual Pell Grant Recipients in Failing GE Programs (AY2025)

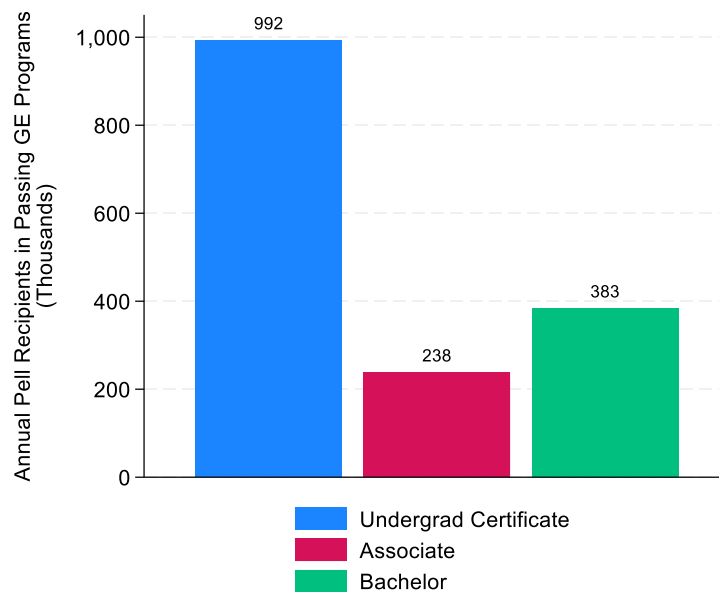

Figure 3. Annual Pell Grant Volume to Passing GE Programs (AY2025)



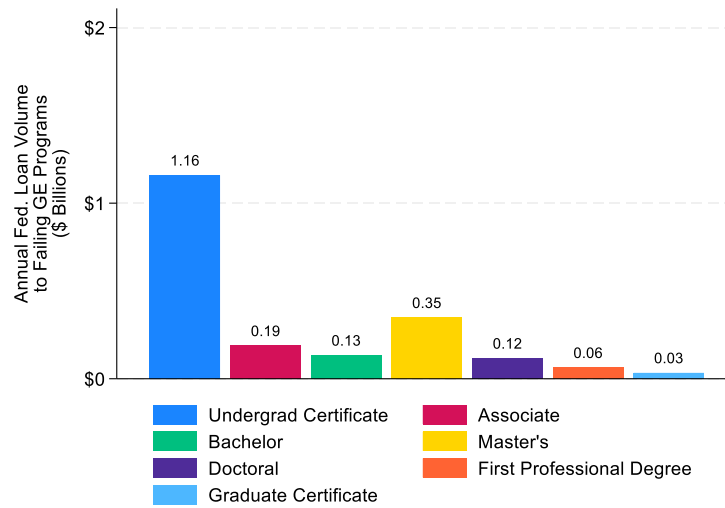

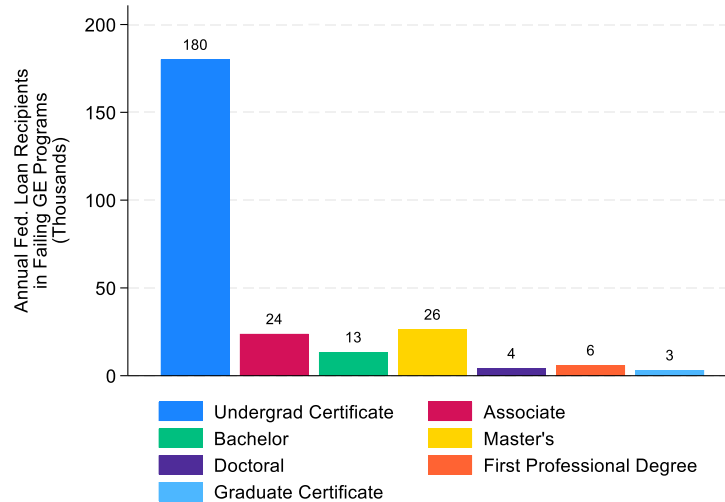
Figure 5. Annual Federal Student Loan Volume to Failing GE Programs (AY2025)

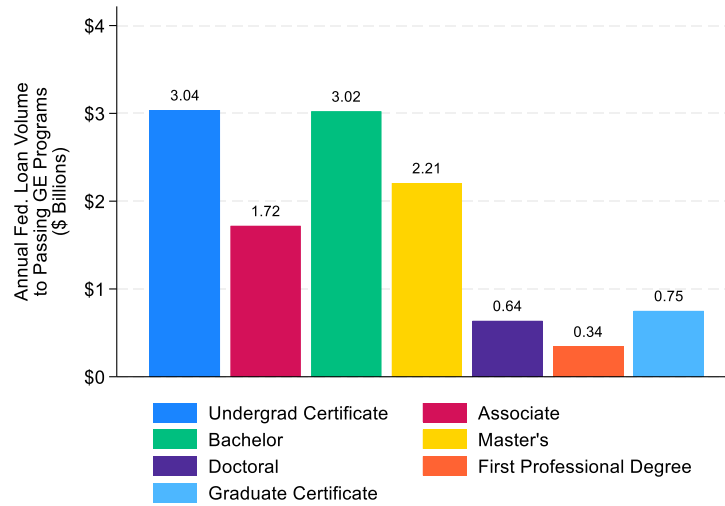
Figure 6. Annual Federal Student Loan Recipients in Failing GE Programs (AY2025)

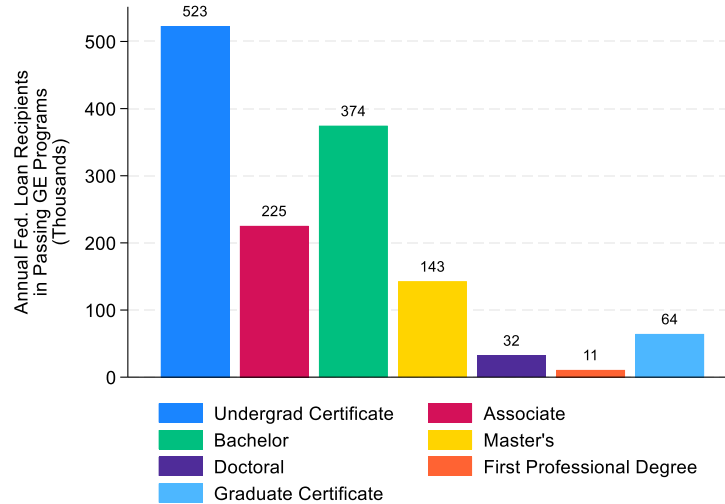
