

ABSTRACT

Name of Applicant: California State University San Marcos Corporation, on behalf of California State University San Marcos (CSUSM) **City/State:** San Marcos, California

Project Objectives/Activities: CSUSM, a four-year public university is proposing to continue providing CAMP support services to address the needs of eligible migrant and seasonal farmworkers (MSFW). Leveraging university and local community resources, CSUSM's goal is to **recruit and enroll 40 eligible residential and commuter MSFW who are most of in need of social, emotional, and academic support, career development, financial aid, and resources**, to have them complete their first academic year, and subsequently re-enroll for degree attainment. **CSUSM CAMP's annual objectives and outcomes are:** **Objective 1:** Recruit and enroll 40 eligible MSFW. **Objective 2:** (GPRA 1): 86% of CAMP participants will successfully complete their first year of college. **Objective 3:** (GPRA 2): 92% of CAMP completers (GPRA 1) will continue to be enrolled in postsecondary education. **Objective 4:** 100% of CAMP Scholars' basic needs will be met (direct support and/or referrals for food, housing, and health services). **Objective 5:** 100% of new CAMP Scholars will complete a career development plan to be utilized as an evolving document during their undergraduate career as a tool for post-CSUSM. **All of CAMP's objectives, activities, timelines and benchmarks, ensure a specific and efficient plan of operation.**

Applicable Priorities: CSUSM responds for consideration to the following: **Preference Priority 1 - Meeting Student Social, Emotional, and Academic Needs;** and **Preference Priority 2 - Consideration of Prior Experience,** current CAMP award, totaling 20 years of experience.

Proposed Site: Operations on one campus, main CSUSM campus, to support 40 students.
