



ABSTRACT

Name of Applicant: Central Washington University (CWU) **City/State:** Ellensburg, Washington.

Project Objectives/Activities: CWU, a four-year public university, is proposing to continue offering CAMP support services to address the needs of eligible migrant and seasonal farmworker (MSFW) students. CWU CAMP's **goal** is to **recruit & enroll 45 eligible residential and commuter MSFW students on a full-time basis in the first year and provide them with intensive academic, career, financial, and support services** they need to **successfully complete their first academic year**. CWU CAMP's **annual objectives and outcomes** are: **Objective 1:** Recruit and enroll 45 eligible MSFWs annually who are most in need of social, academic, and financial based support services and resources. **Objective 2:** (GPRA 1): **86%** of CAMP participants will successfully complete their first year of college. **Objective 3:** (GPRA 2): **92%** of CAMP completers (GPRA 1) will continue to be enrolled in postsecondary education. **Objective 4:** Provide annual follow-up support services to still enrolled CAMP participants in order to facilitate degree program completion. **Applicable Priorities:** CWU addresses: **Competitive Preference Priority 1 - Promoting Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math (STEM) Education, With a Particular Focus on Computer Science;** and **Competitive Preference Priority 2 - Consideration of Prior Experience** as a successful 20-year CAMP grant recipient.

Participants/Sites: CWU CAMP will offer services to 45 eligible students who attend the main campus in Ellensburg, WA.
