



**ABSTRACT**

**Name of Applicant:** Colorado State University (CSU). **City/State:** Fort Collins, Colorado.

**Project Objectives/Activities:** CSU, a four-year public university, is proposing to offer CAMP services to address the needs of its Migrant and Seasonal Farmworker (MSFW) students. CSU CAMP's goal is to provide **30 eligible residential students enrolled on a full-time bases in the first year** with holistic support to reach their educational and career goals including academic, career, financial, and support services. **CSU CAMP's annual objectives and outcomes are: 1)** Conduct yearly outreach efforts to underrepresented potential participants and recruit 30 eligible MSFWs who are most in need of CAMP support services, and provided comprehensive enrollment, transition and orientation services; **(2)** Provide 30 eligible MSFW students with academic support to successfully complete their first year at CSU & continue in postsecondary education; **(3)** Provide 30 students with academic, personal and career counseling, and academic advising to support the successful completion of their first year; **(4)** Provide 30 students with financial assistance and access to federal, state, private, and institutional resources to support their first year at the university; and **(5)** Provide follow-up services to support student's retention and graduation rates through academic and financial support after completing their first year..

**Priorities:** CSU addresses **Invitational Priority:** Meeting Student Social, Emotional, and Academic Needs. **Participant/Sites:** CSU CAMP will offer residential services to 30 eligible students who attend the main campus in Fort. Collins, CO. They will also provide services to students who live off campus and commute. **Government Performance Results Act (GPRA) Measures:** Of the 30 MSFW students served annually, **86% (26)** will successfully complete their first year of college (**GPRA 1**) and **92% (28)** of those students will continue to be enrolled in post-secondary education (**GPRA 2**).
