Number of Participants Served Annually – 50 students' commuter/residential

Number and Location of Proposed Project: 4 Locations: CSUSB, CSUSB – Palm Desert Campus, OFCV Headquarters, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Coachella Valley – Mecca Club

Applicable Priorities: IP 1: Meeting Student Social, Emotional, and Academic Needs.

Project Objectives: (1) Participants will complete 1st year of PSE. (2) Participants will continue into 2nd year of PSE. (3) Participants will increase workforce readiness skills. (4) Participants will have opportunities for holistic student support and enrichment, including social, emotional and academic needs.

Project Activities: **Academic Support** (College and career planning, progress tracking, advising, tutoring, summer residential program, STEM and supplemental curriculum) **Financial** (Family financial aid workshops and application assistance, book loan program, scholarship assistance, employment connections, opportunities for fellowships and internships, career preparation.) **Personal/Resources** (Leadership development, mental health and wellness programming, college tours, cultural experiences, connections to basics needs resources)

Proposed Project Outcomes: GPRA #1: 86% of CAMP program participants will complete their first year of post-secondary education. GPRA #2: 92% of CAMP program participants will continue into their post-secondary education after completing the first academic year of college.
