**Objectives:** 1. Recruit 38 MSFW eligible students, 2. Provide participants with admission and academic support, 3. STEM academic, career and personal counseling and advising, 4. Financial aid and literacy support and assistance, 5. Provide follow-up and academic support.

**Activities:** Will include a STEM 101/ First Year Experience (FYE) Course, Academic Advising & Course Selection, Academic Tutoring/Mentoring, Cultural Enrichment and Community Service, Welcome Events, Financial Aid Advising/Assistance, STEM Career and Leadership Activities, Academic Supplemental Support/Monitoring and Family Involvement.

**Priorities:** Competitive Preference **Priority 1** – Promoting STEM or Math Education, with a particular focus on Computer Science.

**Project Outcomes:** 100% of students will attend CAMP orientation, enroll in First Year Experience course, attend STEM workshops, provided tutoring and mentoring, attend multicultural and leadership activities, complete their first year of college, will receive academic advising and counseling, will have an IEP completed, participate in study groups, will complete FAFSA, be trained on accessing scholarships, attend financial literacy workshops, receive follow-up and monitoring and career services.

**Number Participants Served and Location:** 38 students will be served on EWU's main campus in Cheney, WA in a residential program.

**GPRA Project Targets:** GPRA 1: 88% of CAMP participants will complete their first year of post-secondary. GPRA 2: 95% of CAMP participants who complete their first academic year of college will continue their postsecondary education.
