

Fiscal Year 2024 Summary of Funding

For Fiscal Year (FY) 2024, the Developing Hispanic-Serving Institutions (DHSI) Program's total appropriation was \$228,890,000. Of this amount, \$28,086,011 was used to fund 49 highly ranked applicants that applied to the FY 2023 DHSI grant competition. The 49 grantees that were *funded down* the FY 2023 slate of new awards are listed below.
