

Abstract

Name of Applicant: Heritage University (HU)

City/State: Toppenish, Washington

Project Objectives & Activities: HU CAMP's objectives and outcomes are: **1)** Provide outreach to underrepresented potential participants and recruit 55 eligible MSFWs who are most in need of academic instruction and supportive services; **2)** Provide CAMP students with intensive academic, and support services during their first year of college and continue in postsecondary education; **3)** Provide 55 students with academic, career and personal counseling and advising services to enable them to succeed in their first year at the university; **4)** Provide 55 students with financial aid assistance and access to federal, state, private and institutional resources to support their first year at the university; **5)** Provide follow-up services to enhance student's retention and graduation rates through academic and financial support after completing their first year of college.

Applicable Priorities: HU CAMP will address the competitive preference priority STEM and the prior experience of service delivery.

Proposed Project Outcomes: 1) 400 potential participants will be informed about HU CAMP program. 2) 100% of enrolled students will attend required academic and support services throughout the academic year. 3) 100% of second year continuing students will be transitioned and encouraged to participate in the academic and support services available at HU.

Number of Participants: HU CAMP will serve 55 eligible commuter students annually. **Number and location of proposed sites:** The CAMP project will be located on HU campus. **Project**

GPRA Measures: 1. **86%** will successfully complete their first year of college (GPRA 1). 2. **92%** of those students will continue to be enrolled in post-secondary education (GPRA 2).
