PROJECT GOAL 1: Recruit, enroll and support migrant students to HSE attainment	
Objective 1:	CCHEP will identify, recruit, and select 85 qualifying participants.
Objective 2:	All participants will be assessed and placed at appropriate levels of HSE.
Objective 3: (GPRA 1)	69% of CCHEP participants will complete the program and receive their HSE
PROJECT GOAL 2: Increase postsecondary placement of migrant students	
Objective 4: (GPRA 2).	80% of HSE attainers will enroll in PSE/upgrade employment/enlist in military

Crowder College High School Equivalency (CCHEP) has developed goals and outcomes to: identify, recruit, and select migrant and seasonal farmworker (MSFW) eligible participants; to adequately assess participant needs; to provide high quality, accessible educational services; and to ensure participants enter post-secondary education, a career, and/or military service.

Educational services include: computer literacy, classroom, small group, and individual instruction; tutoring; learning style assessment; study and test taking development and workshops such as, addressing the necessary skills which are required by employers.

Applicable Priorities: CCHEP will address the **Competitive Preference Priority 1** by providing a Pathway Training workshop series for obtaining necessary skills for in-demand sectors and occupations. **Proposed Outcomes:** 69% of participants will attain HSE diploma and 80% of participants will enroll in postsecondary/upgrade employment/ enlist in military. **Number of participants:** **85 commuters** annually; **Number of locations:** CCHEP will provide HSE services in the four states, 6 different class sites, partnering with Adult Education Literacy Program and the Migrant Education Program. **Project GPRA Targets are:** 69% for GPRA 1 and 80% and GPRA 2.
