

Lewis-Clark State College CAMP Abstract

(Name of Applicant) Lewis-Clark State College (LCSC) requests funds from the United States Department of Education to implement and operate the College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP) described herein at its *(number and location of proposed sites)* main campus in *(City/State)* Lewiston, Idaho. LCSC CAMP will serve eligible migrant seasonal farm workers (MSFW) and their families from the state of Idaho - identifying, recruiting, enrolling and retaining *(number of participants to be served annually)* 30 eligible participants per year. LCSC CAMP strategic recruitment plan will provide a bilingual recruiter that identifies and attends/participates in events/locations where MSFW reside. *(proposed project outcomes)* As LCSC CAMP targets a statewide population, we anticipate that *(commuter/residential)* 80% of the participants will reside on campus, with the other 20% commuting from surrounding communities. In accordance with GRPA 1 and 2, LCSC's CAMP is designed with the goal that 86% of participants will complete their first year of college and 92% will return for their second year at LCSC. LCSC CAMP will provide comprehensive retention efforts through individual educational plans, three credit freshman success course (SD 110) academic tutoring, career assessments, housing learning community, to meet needs of MSFW students; while collaborating with organizations to provide *(follow-up)* services. *(project and objectives)* LCSC CAMP will rely on the following goals and objectives to achieve the GPRA requirements: Goal 1 - Support The Success Of MSFW Students In Enrolling And Completing Their First Year Of College (GPRA 1) and Goal 2 - Building on the Structures Built in Goal 1, CAMP Students will continue their postsecondary path towards degree completion (GPRA 2). *(applicable priorities)* LCSC CAMP will participate in Competitive Preference Priority 1 – by providing participants access to STEM internships, apprenticeships, or other work-based learning experiences, including computer science and Competitive Preference Priority #2 as a consideration of prior experience.
