

## ABSTRACT

1. Promotes STEM education with a particular focus in computer science.
2. Consideration of Prior Experience.

**Goals:** The goal is continue offering CAMP services to Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers students and provide a residential university experience supported by financial assistance and academic and social services to help these students complete their first year of postsecondary education and persist as college students. MU will provide mentoring, service learning, STEM curriculum, and access to STEM internships, apprenticeships, or work-based learning experiences.

### Objectives Project Targets

1. Recruitment of 25 students each year of a 5 years program.
2. 87% of participant complete their first year of postsecondary education.
3. Matriculation of at least 92% of students to their second year of college,
4. 100% of students exposed to STEM disciplines with a particular focus in Computer Science and access to STEM internships, apprenticeships, or other work-based learning exp.
5. 100% of students provided broad-based academic, social/personal and financial services.

The project will be evaluated using formative and summative methods as well as mixed methods to ensure continuous improvement, effective management, and attainment of proposed outcomes. This project follows a logic model aligning project goals, services, and personnel to the needs of migrant children seeking postsecondary education who are interested.
