Grantees should have previously confirmed that all CARES and CRRSA FFATA subaward reporting is also accurate and complete. If you have not yet confirmed, or if you have made edits since confirming, please verify that reporting for those programs is accurate and complete as soon as possible by sending an email through your State mailbox at [Statename].OESE@ed.gov. Grantees are reminded that all ARP subawards should have been reported to the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA) Subaward Reporting System (FSRS) at <http://www.frs.gov> by **10/31/24**. **Link:** [FFATA reporting reminder](#)
