

CCE Pathways for Prospective Educator Success

The Center for Collaborative Education (CCE) and its partner community colleges respectfully request funding for the Pathways for Prospective Educator Success project. Through this project, CCE will work collaboratively with five community colleges to strategically address student success in teacher preparation programs 2+2 degree pathways in southern Los Angeles.

The project will focus on supporting historically underrepresented students through a comprehensive support intervention that brings together enhanced advisory mentoring with financial supports to overcome barriers to success commonly faced by low-income, racially minoritized and first-generation-in-college students. This mid-phase project builds upon our foundational work with a previous SEED-funded CPTP project. CCE is partnering with WestEd to conduct a rigorous RCT evaluation to generate meaningful, empirical data necessary for scale-up and replication. The potential contribution of this project is contribution to the literature on the impact of holistic support programs and strategies for supporting vulnerable students in community college pathways. Project partners include Rio Hondo, El Camino, East LA, Antelope Valley, and West LA.
