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### **Recent Grantee Communication**

**Sent 10/25/24 – FFATA Reporting for ESSER, GEER, and EANS Grantees:** Grantees received a communication about the FFATA reporting requirements for all ESSER, GEER, and EANS subawards. All ARP subawards must be reported to the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA) Subaward Reporting System (FSRS) at <http://www.fsrs.gov> by October 31, 2024. Grantees must also confirm through their State mailbox by November 15, 2024, that all ARP FFATA subaward reporting is accurate and complete. Grantees should have previously confirmed that all CARES and CRRSA FFATA subaward reporting is also accurate and complete. If you have not yet confirmed, or if you have made edits since confirming, please verify that reporting for those programs is accurate and complete by November 15, 2024. **Link:** [FFATA reporting reminder](#)

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### **Deadlines and Announcements**

**EANS Year 3 (FY23) Annual Performance Reporting (APR) Open for Corrections and Updates:** Grantees may now make corrections and updates to their previously submitted EANS Year 3 (FY23) APR data. The re-open period will close at 8pm ET on **11/7/24**. If your State received an email in mid-August with potential EANS Year 3 (FY23) APR data quality concerns identified by the Department, you should review the data in the [ESF Data Collection Tool](#) for accuracy and, if necessary, make any updates and resubmit the data. If updates were made to your EANS Year 2 (FY 22) APR, they should be reconciled with the updates made to your EANS Year 3 (FY23) APR.

**ESF Reporting Helpdesk Office Hours:** The ESF Reporting Helpdesk will host an Office Hours session on Wednesday, **10/30/24**, 3pm-4pm ET, to discuss questions regarding the EANS Year 3 (FY23) APR submissions and the data quality findings received by email. **GEER/ESF-GOV Year 4 (FY23) Annual Performance Reporting (APR) Closing:** The re-open period for grantees to make corrections and updates to their previously submitted GEER/ESF-Governor Year 4 (FY23) APR data will close at 8pm ET on **10/31/24**, after which all GEER/ESF-Governor Year 4 (FY23) APR data will be considered final and the [ESF Data Collection Tool](#) will not be available for further corrections. If your State or Outlying Area received an email in mid-August with potential data quality concerns identified by the Department within your GEER/ESF-Governor Year 4 (FY23)

APR, you should review the data within the ESF Data Collection Tool for accuracy and, if necessary, make any updates and resubmit the data. If updates were made to your GEER/ESF-Governor Year 3 (FY22) APR, they should be reconciled with the updates made to your GEER/ESF-Governor Year 4 (FY23) APR.
