

Name & Location of Applicant: Skagit Valley College (SVC) - Mount Vernon, WA

Project Goals & Objectives: The goal is to provide academic and financial support services to eligible students from migrant seasonal farmworker families in order to complete their first academic year of college and continue in postsecondary for a second year. **Objective 1:** Recruit and enroll 30 eligible students in Year 1, and 35 students each year in Years 2-5. **Objective 2:** 86% of CAMP students will complete their first academic year in good academic standing (GPRA 1). **Objective 3:** 92% of CAMP students who complete their first academic year will enroll in their second year of college (GPRA 2). **Activities and Services:** Outreach and recruitment events, family engagement, college success skills course, one-on-one education navigation, financial literacy and planning, mentoring and tutoring, remote learning support, educational and cultural enrichment activities, support for transportation, housing, and emergency assistance, and STEM educational and work-based learning opportunities. **Project Outcomes:** 100% of CAMP students develop individual education plans, financial plans, and career goals; 100% of CAMP students will have access to at least one supplemental activity quarterly (workshops on study skills, growth mindset, and cultural/educational activities); 100% of CAMP students will have access to mentoring, tutoring. **Number of Participants:** Serve 170 commuter students over 5 years (Year 1: 30 students; Years 2-5: 35 students) **Number & Location of Sites:** One site at the SVC Mount Vernon campus that serves the Northwest WA region. **Applicable Priorities:** **Competitive Preference Priority 1** - Promoting STEM education with a focus on Computer Science. **Invitational Priority 1** - New Potential Grantee. **Invitational Priority 2** – Support for Remote Learning. **Five-Year Total Budget Request:** \$2,372,694 (\$13,957 average cost per student).
