



ABSTRACT

PROJECT OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES:

Reedley College proposes a CAMP project that will serve 60 freshman students from migrant farmworker families each year. Students will receive academic assistance, help with financial aid, workshops, cultural events and activities, counseling, peer mentoring, and career awareness activities. Objectives are: 1) Recruit and enroll 60 students each year; 2) Provide 60 students with academic support; 3) Provide financial aid and financial literacy; 4) Provide counseling and psycho-social support; and 5) Provide cultural awareness and service projects.

PROPOSED PROJECT OUTCOMES:

1. All students will complete 12 units each semester.
2. All students will receive academic placement assessments.
3. All students will receive a fully-funded financial aid package.
4. Students will feel empowered to overcome barriers to success.
5. All students will participate in cultural awareness and service activities
