



ABSTRACT

PROJECT OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES:

Madera Community College proposes a CAMP project that will serve 70 freshman students from migrant farmworker families each year. Students will receive academic assistance, help with financial aid, workshops, cultural events and activities, counseling, peer mentoring, and career awareness activities. Objectives are: 1) Recruit and enroll 70 students each year; 2) Provide 70 students with academic support; 3) Provide financial aid and financial literacy; 4) Provide counseling and psycho-social support; and 5) Provide cultural awareness and service projects.

PROPOSED PROJECT OUTCOMES:

1. All students will complete 12 units each semester.
2. All students will receive academic placement assessments.
3. All students will receive a fully-funded financial aid package.
4. Students will feel empowered to overcome barriers to success.
5. All students will participate in cultural awareness and service activities

COMPETITIVE PREFERENCE PRIORITIES:

- **Priority 1: Promoting Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math (STEM) Education, With a Particular Focus on Computer Science.** MCC CAMP will offer a learning community cohort for STEM students that includes cohort-based classes, STEM career awareness, and STEM-oriented campus visits and cultural events.
- **Priority 2: Prior Experience.** MCC is applying for its first CAMP program.

INVITATIONAL PRIORITIES:

- **Priority 1: New Potential Grantees.** MCC is applying for its first CAMP program.
- **Priority 2: Support for Remote Learning.** MCC will support remote learning through guidance classes that focus on success in online instruction.
