

Abstract

**Name of applicant:** Inter American University of Puerto Rico (IAUPR-SG) a four-year institution. **City/State:** San German, PR. **Project objectives/activities:** The goal of IAUPR CAMP will be to assist and support students from MSFW backgrounds to enroll and complete their first year in college, continue during their second year in college and achieve a post-secondary degree. **Objectives:** 1) By the end of each fiscal year, 50 eligible migrant or seasonal farmworker students will be recruited and served by CAMP. 2) At least 86% of CAMP participants will complete their first academic year at IAUPR during each year of the grant period. 3) Provide financial support services throughout the academic year to all CAMP participated during each year of the grant period. 4) At least 80% of students will attend CAMP Pre-College Experience at IAUPR-San German before the beginning of the first semester during each year of the grant period. 5) At least 92% of students will continue into their third semester of studies during each year of the grant period. 6) To follow-up and monitor academic progress of participants every semester to ensure that at least 85% of them meet the institutional academic progress norm through their 5<sup>th</sup> year of studies. **Invitational priority 1: Students Social, Emotional, Academic Needs and Competitive Prior Experience. Project outcomes per year:** 1) 50 eligible students recruited and admitted; 2) 86% will complete their first academic year; 3) 100% of participants will complete their FAFSA application and receive CAMP economic funding for stipends; 4) At least 80% of students will attend the CAMP Pre-College Experience; 5) At least 92% of students will continue into their 2<sup>nd</sup> year; 6) 100% of students will be monitored for compliance with IAUPR satisfactory academic progress norm through the 5<sup>th</sup> year of studies. **Participants:** 50 students from MSFW backgrounds per year. (42 commuters and 8 residential.) **GPRA targets:** 86% will successfully complete their first year of college (**GPRA1**) and 92% of those students will continue to be enrolled in post-secondary education (**GPRA2**).
