

Abstract

Project Objectives and Activities:

1. Conduct recruitment of CAMP-eligible students.
 - 1.1 Coordinate with committed partners to recruit eligible students (24 events annually).
2. Ensure 45 students complete CAMP Orientation and a Student Education Plan annually.
 - 2.1 Conduct orientation, need assessment, and develop Education Plan (100% of students).
3. Provide tutorial services to 45 students annually.
 - 3.1 Tutorial services provided online and face-to-face by CAMP staff (90%).
4. Provide academic advising, supportive services, and stipends to 45 students annually
 - 4.1 Review student progress monthly; 4.2 Disperse activity completion stipends (100%).
5. Expose 45 students to education, cultural, life-skill, career, and STEM activities annually.
 - 5.1 Visit universities and enrichment activities; 5.2 Participation in STEM research (90%)

Proposed Project Outcomes:

1. Serve 45 CAMP-eligible students each year.
2. **(GPRA 1)** 86% of CAMP students successfully complete the first year of college.
3. **(GPRA 2)** 92% of CAMP completers transition to the second year of college.
