The School-Based Mental Health (SBMH) Services program is designed to address several barriers to increasing mental health support for children and youth in our schools. SBMH programs are intended to address personnel shortages by:

- (1) increasing recruitment and retention-related incentives and
- (2) promoting the re-specialization and certification of existing mental health services providers to qualify them for work in local educational agencies (LEAs) with demonstrated need.
