FFATA Subaward Reporting Requirements: Grantees are asked to verify the accuracy and completeness of FFATA subaward reporting for each ARP Act program by **11/15/24**. FFATA subaward reporting for CARES Act and CRRSA Act programs should have been verified for accuracy and completeness by **5/18/24**.
